Senator Edwards

moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 2-5, by rewriting the lines to read:

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE COMPLIANCE WITH IMMIGRATION DETAINERS AND ADMINISTRATIVE WARRANTS AND TO REQUIRE CERTAIN REPORTS FROM LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT.";

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and on page 1, line 9, by rewriting the line to read:

"(a) When any person charged with a felony or an impaired drivingcriminal offense is confined";

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and on page 1, lines 21-32, by rewriting the lines to read:

"(b1) When any person charged with a criminal offense is confined for any period in a county jail, local confinement facility, district confinement facility, satellite jail, or work release unit, and the administrator or other person in charge of the facility has been notified that Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the United States Department of Homeland Security has issued a detainer and administrative warrant that reasonably appears to be for the person in custody, the following shall apply:

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(1)

Prior to the prisoner's release, and after receipt of the detainer and administrative warrant, or a copy thereof, by the administrator or other person in charge of the facility, the prisoner shall be taken without unnecessary delay before a State judicial official who shall be provided with the detainer and administrative warrant, or a copy thereof.

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(2) The judicial official shall issue an order directing the prisoner be held in custody if the prisoner appearing before the judicial official is the same person subject to the detainer and administrative warrant.

25 26 27 (3) Unless continued custody of the prisoner is required by other legal process, a prisoner held pursuant to an order issued under this subsection shall be released upon the first of the following conditions:

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The passage of 48 hours from receipt of the detainer and administrative warrant.

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Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the United States
 Department of Homeland Security takes custody of the prisoner.
